

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Town of Colorado City, Arizona, will receive sealed proposals for construction of the **Arizona Division of Emergency Management – Colorado City Flooding – Richard Street and Central Street Projects**. Proposals must be submitted to the Town of Colorado City, ATTN: Vance Barlow, Town Clerk, 25 S. Central St., P.O. Box 70, Colorado City, Arizona, 86021, by 3 p.m. Mountain Daylight Time on or before Wednesday, May 18, 2016, and will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter. All proposals shall be plainly marked on the outside of the sealed envelope with the name of the Contractor, “Colorado City Flooding,” “ADEM PCA 73033,” and “Town of Colorado City.” Any proposal received after 3:00 p.m. of the above specified opening date will be returned unopened.

A pre-proposal meeting will be held at the above address on Wednesday, May 11, 2016, at 3 p.m. Mountain Daylight Time. Attendance is optional. Notes from the meeting will be sent to all plan holders.

Proposals shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier’s check, or surety bond for 10% (ten percent) of the total amount of the proposal. The Town intends to enter into a unit price contract with the lowest responsible and responsive bidder whose proposal is satisfactory. The comparison of the proposals will be based on the final scope of the project as determined by the Town. The Contract amount will be based upon estimated quantities of this final scope and the identical unit prices submitted in the proposal. Performance and payment bonds for not less than 100% (one hundred percent) of the agreed upon full contract amount will be required of the successful bidder.

Project scope consists of two projects that may be awarded separately or together. The Richard Street Project consists of the repair of a low-water crossing structure, including replacement of 30 lineal feet of concrete turndown wall, placement of 193 cubic yards of controlled low-strength material, replacement of 260 square feet of concrete apron, replacement of 750 square feet of concrete slope, replacement of 171 lineal feet of safety railing with anchor plates, and associated demolition, traffic control, and dewatering. The construction cost is expected to be between \$50,000 and \$100,000. The completion time for the project will be 30 calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed.

The Central Street Project consists of the repair of a low-water crossing structure, including replacement of 231 square feet of sidewalk with 50 cubic yards of fill, replacement of 475 lineal feet of safety railing with anchor plates, replacement of 2 steel pipe closure gates, and associated demolition, traffic control, and dewatering. The construction cost is expected to be between \$25,000 and \$50,000. The completion time for the project will be 30 calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed.

Substantial answers will be issued in writing to all plan holders.

Contractors must submit evidence that they are fully prepared and have the necessary licenses, experience, capital and equipment to complete the contract. The Town of Colorado City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to withhold the award for any reason, or to waive any formalities or minor defects.

This is a State and locally funded project. The requirements of all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations must be met.
